

WHEREAS, BOB served as the only Chief, Office of Operator Certification from the start of the program until his retirement in December 1984; and


WHEREAS, the Board's Operator Certification program has gained national recognition and status through BOB's diligent work.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board members extend to BOB and his wife their best wishes.
