STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 84-85

APPROVING A GRANT INCREASE FOR THE CITY OF SAN BERNARDINO'S CORRECTIVE ACTION PROJECT FOR SOLIDS HANDLING

WHEREAS:

- The City of San Bernardino received a Clean Water Grant in 1970 for \$9.2 million, which included a Farrer heat treatment and sludge incineration system;
- 2. The Farrer system has never performed satisfactorily;
- 3. The City of San Bernardino returned about \$1.5 million to the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) for this inoperative system;
- 4. The State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) and EPA intended to provide grant funds to the City of San Bernardino for an equivalent solids handling system to replace the inoperative sludge disposal system;
- 5. The EPA regulations, dated February 17, 1984, do not allow grant funding for replacement of inoperative treatment works; and
- 6. The City of San Bernardino requested and received a deviation from EPA regulations on September 13, 1984.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board hereby approves a grant increase (by amendment) to fund the City of San Bernardino's corrective action project for solids handling.
