# STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 84-89

APPROVAL OF THE TOXICS SPECIAL PROJECT PHASE II
"208" REPORT TITLED "PESTICIDES AND WATER QUALITY A CALIFORNIA RISK ASSESSMENT PROGRAM"

#### WHEREAS:

- 1. The State Water Resources Control Board is responsible for the statewide Section 208 Areawide Waste Treatment Management Planning Program in accordance with the Federal Water Pollution Control Act of 1972 and subsequent amendments;
- 2. The Phase II 208 "Pesticides and Water Quality A California Risk Assessment Program" workplan objectives called for:
  - A systematic study of pesticide use in California to determine significant impacts on beneficial uses of water,
  - b. A review of available data to identify specific use patterns which impact water quality,
  - c. Published reports to provide a data base of water quality impact information not currently available to decision makers at all levels.
  - d. Mitigation measures when appropriate, and
- 3. The findings and recommendations of the program are contained in the Phase II 208 final report entitled, "PESTICIDES AND WATER QUALITY - A CALIFORNIA RISK ASSESSMENT PROGRAM"; and
- 4. The State Board has reviewed the Phase II 208 final report titled "Pesticides and Water Quality A California Risk Assessment Program" and finds that it fulfills the 208 Workplan objectives.



## THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

## That the State Board:

- 1. Approves the Phase II 208 final report titled "Pesticides and Water Quality A California Risk Assessment Program", and
- Directs the Executive Director to transmit a copy of the final report to EPA for its review and approval.
