STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 85-16

ACCEPTANCE OF THE DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES' PHASE II
208 SLOPE STABILITY HAZARD ZONE MAPS AND FINAL
REPORT ENTITLED "WATERSHED MANAGEMENT FOR UNSTABLE AND
ERODIBLE AREAS IN NORTH COASTAL CALIFORNIA"

WHEREAS:

- 1. The State Board is responsible for conducting Section 208 planning in accordance with the Federal Water Pollution Control Act.
- 2. The State Board, on behalf of the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, North Coast Region, (North Coast Regional Board) entered into an Interagency Agreement (No. 0-046-118-0) with the Department of Water Resources to produce a set of slope stability hazard zone maps of a key watershed in the North Coast region and a final report to accompany the maps.
- 3. The Interagency Agreement was funded by a Phase II 208 grant from the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency.
- 4. The staff of the Department of Water Resources prepared a set of slope stability hazard zone maps for the Blue Creek, Turwar Creek, and Grouse Creek watersheds and submitted them with the final report entitled "Watershed Management for Unstable and Erodible Areas in North Coastal California" as completion of their Interagency Agreement.
- 5. The staff of the North Coast Regional Board has reviewed the Phase II 208 slope stability hazard zone maps and final report entitled "Watershed Management for Unstable and Erodible Areas in North Coastal California" and found that they satisfy the terms of the Interagency Agreement and recommends that the State Board accept the maps and final report as completion of the agreement.
- 6. The State Board has reviewed the Phase II 208 slope stability hazard zone maps and final report entitled "Watershed Management for Unstable and Erodible Areas in North Coastal California" and found that the maps and final report fulfill the terms of the Interagency Agreement.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board:

1. Accepts the Phase II 208 slope stability hazard zone maps and final report entitled "Watershed Management for Unstable and Erodible Areas in North Coastal California" as completion of Interagency Agreement No. 0-046-118-0.

- 2. Notes that acceptance of the report entitled "Watershed Management for Unstable and Erodible Areas in North Coastal California" does not imply that the recommended best management practices included in the report are certified.
- 3. Directs the Executive Director to transmit a copy of the Phase II 208 final report entitled "Watershed Management for Unstable and Erodible Areas in North Coastal California" to the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency as completion of the Phase II 208 Watershed Mapping project.
