STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 85-22

AUTHORIZING NEGOTIATION AND EXECUTION OF A CONTRACT WITH THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR THE SAN DIEGO/TIJUANA BORDER WATER QUALITY PROBLEM

WHEREAS:

- 1. The State Budget Act of 1984, as amended by AB 3544, appropriated \$5,365,000 for local assistance to construct a treatment facility to handle raw sewage entering the United States from Tijuana.
- The City of San Diego has made an application for funds needed to plan, design and construct facilities for treatment of wastewater flowing into the United States from Tijuana, Mexico.
- 3. The Board has determined that the facilities proposed by the applicant are necessary to prevent water pollution.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Executive Director be authorized to negotiate and execute a contract with the City of San Diego for the San Diego/Tijuana border water quality problem in an amount not to exceed \$5,365,000.
