## STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 85-27

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE AN INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES FOR SURFACE WATER QUALITY MONITORING STUDIES THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30,1986

## WHEREAS:

- The State Water Resources Control Board (State Board) requires baseline and trend water quality data at key locations statewide to assist in defining water quality problems and issues and in providing water quality assessment reports to the California Regional Water Quality Control Boards.
- 2. The Department of Water Resources operates a water quality monitoring network on a long-term basis and provides the State Board with a cooperative, cost-effective means for sample collection and laboratory analysis, data evaluation and reporting.
- 3. The Department of Water Resources has the staff and technical capability to provide the specified services and desires to continue to provide such services to the State Board through September 1986.

## THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board authorize the Executive Director to negotiate and execute an Interagency Agreement with the Department of Water Resources for surface water quality monitoring studies through September 30, 1986 in an amount not to exceed \$170,000 in F. Y. 1985-86 Bond Fund monies, subject to availability of funds.
