STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 85-32

APPROVAL OF THE PHASE IV 208 FINAL REPORT, "CONTROL OF PESTICIDE DISCHARGES TO NORTH COAST WATERS"

WHEREAS:

- 1. The State Board is responsible for conducting Section 208 planning in accordance with the Federal Water Pollution Control Act.
- 2. The staff of the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, North Coast Region, prepared a final report, "Control of Pesticide Discharge to North Coast Waters", as part of its Phase IV 208 study.
- 3. The North Coast Regional Board approved the Phase IV 208 final report, "Control of Pesticide Discharges to North Coast Waters", at its May 31, 1984 meeting and instructed its staff to send the final report to the State Board for its review and approval.
- 4. The State Board has reviewed the Phase IV 208 final report "Control of Pesticide Discharge to North Coast Waters", and found that it fulfills the Phase IV 208 study workplan.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board:

- Approves the Phase IV 208 final report, "Control of Pesticide Discharges to North Coast Waters", prepared by the staff of the North Coast Regional Board, as completion of their Phase IV 208 study workplan.
- 2. Acknowledges the recommendations contained in the report. Resources to implement these recommendations must be obtained through the normal budget process. Approval of this report does not grant special status to these resource needs in the budget process.



2. Directs staff to transmit a copy of the Phase IV 208 final report, "Control of Pesticide Discharges to North Coast Waters", to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency for its review and approval.
