# STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 85-36

### ADOPTION OF IMPLEMENTATION PLAN FOR THE CLEAN WATER BOND LAW OF 1984

### WHEREAS:

- 1. The Clean Water Bond Law of 1984 was passed by the voters on November 6, 1984.
- 2. The Bond Law provides \$250 million for state grants and loans; \$25 million for a reclamation loan program; \$40 million for supplemental grants to small, needy communities; and \$10 million for water conservation.
- 3. The staff has prepared a detailed plan including a policy for implementation of the provisions of the Bond Law.
- 4. The plan was distributed for public review and comment and the Board held a public meeting on April 11, 1985 to receive comments.
- 5. The plan has been modified in response to the comments received.

## THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

- That the May 1985 plan, as amended at the May 2, 1985 Special Board Meeting, including a policy for implementing the provisions of the 1984 Bond Law is approved.
- 2. That the Division of Clean Water Grants continually review the implementation of the Clean Water Bond Law of 1984 to determine whether any policy or procedure needs to be revised to make the program more effective. Division shall recommend to the Board from time to time when such revisions may be required. An annual report shall be prepared for the Board. The first report shall be submitted to the Board by January 1, 1987.
