STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 85-39

APPROVING AN EXCEPTION TO THE POLICY LIMITING STEP 1 AND STEP 2 GRANT INCREASES FOR SANTA BARBARA COUNTY, MISSION CANYON, PROJECT NO. C-06-2474-010

WHEREAS:

- The Board's adopted policy dated September 2, 1982, as amended April 21, 1983, limits the number of Step 1 and Step 2 grant increases to one per grant of less than \$100,000; and
- 2. The County received one Step 1 grant increase on February 3, 1983; and
- Subsequent to the February increase, County and Regional Board staffs recommended additional EIR and ground water monitoring work at an additional estimated cost of \$32,575 (\$24,431 EPA dollars); and
- 4. The County executed contracts and incurred costs to accomplish the additional work and complete the Step 1 facilities plan; and
- 5. The County has requested another grant increase to cover the costs for the additional work.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

1. The Board authorizes a Step 1 grant increase of \$24,431 for Santa Barbara County to cover the additional eligible costs for the EIR and ground water monitoring work necessary to complete the Mission Canyon facilities plan.
