STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 85-45

APPROVING THE SAN DIEGO ASSOCIATION OF GOVERNMENTS' FINAL REPORTS REGARDING THE "FRESHWATER RELEASE AND SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA COASTAL WETLANDS" STUDY

WHEREAS:

- 1. Pursuant to the terms of a first-cycle 205(j) grant from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), the State Water Resources Control Board (State Board) provided funds to the San Diego Association of Governments (SANDAG) to conduct the "Freshwater Release and Southern California Coastal Wetlands" Study (Freshwater Release Study).
- 2. SANDAG has completed the Freshwater Release Study and has submitted a final Management Plan and Technical Report.
- 3. The State Board has found that the above final reports conform to the requirements of the EPA 205(j) grant and to the contract under which SANDAG received funding.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board approves the aforementioned final reports as completion of the contract under which the work was funded, authorizes final payment to SANDAG, and directs staff to transmit the final reports to EPA as completion of the 205(j) "Freshwater Release and Southern California Coastal Wetlands" Study.
