RESOLUTION NO. 85-52

ACCEPTANCE OF THE FINAL REPORT OF THE  
ASSOCIATION OF MONTEREY BAY AREA GOVERNMENTS ENTITLED  
"PAJARO VALLEY IRRIGATION PROJECT"

WHEREAS:

1. Pursuant to the terms of a Phase III 208 grant from the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), funds were provided to the Association of Monterey Bay Area Governments (AMBAG) to conduct the Pajaro Valley Irrigation Project.
2. AMBAG has completed the project and submitted the final report entitled "Pajaro Valley Irrigation Project", dated March 1985.
3. The State Water Resources Control Board is required to evaluate all 208 projects and to inform EPA as to its evaluation.
4. The State Water Resources Control Board has found that the final report entitled "Pajaro Valley Irrigation Project" satisfies the requirements of the Phase III 208 Project workplan.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

1. That the State Board accepts AMBAG's final report entitled "Pajaro Valley Irrigation Project" as completion of the Phase III 208 project.
2. That the State Board staff shall transmit the final report to the Regional Administrator of EPA, Region 9, for approval.
