APPROVAL OF THE SECTION 106 WATER POLLUTION CONTROL GRANT FOR FEDERAL FISCAL YEAR 1985/86

WHEREAS:

- The State Water Resources Control Board (State Board) is applying to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, Region 9, (EPA) for a 106 Grant in the amount of \$3,500,000 for Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 1984/85.
- 2. The Section 106 Grant for water pollution control programs assists the State Board in financing the implementation and maintenance of adequate measures for prevention and abatement of water pollution, pollution control studies, surveillance and enforcement, and technical assistance activities.
- In order to receive federal funds, the State Board will enter into a signed State/EPA agreement on the State Water Quality Management Program for FFY 1985/86.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board hereby:

- Approves the 106 Grant application
- Authorizes the Executive Director to accept a 106 Grant in the amount of \$3,500,000 to assist in financing the State's water pollution control programs.
