ADOPTING THE SECTION 205(g), CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT ASSISTANCE  
GRANT APPLICATION  
STATE FISCAL YEAR 1985-86  
FEDERAL FISCAL YEAR 1986

WHEREAS:


1. The State Water Resources Control Board is applying to the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency, Region 9, for a Construction Management Assistance Grant (CMAG) in the amount of \$9,943,521 for Federal Fiscal Year 1986;
2. The Section 205(g) Grant finances the administration costs of California's Clean Water Construction Grants Program, provides funding support for the NPDES permits related work and up to \$150,000 for the Operator Training Program;
3. The responsibility for managing the Construction Grants Program has been delegated to the State Water Resources Control Board through the Agreement in Principle; and,
4. In order to receive federal funds, the State Board will retain the existing agreement or revise and sign the Agreement in Principle between EPA and the State Board.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

1. That the State Board approves the Grant Application for the amount requested.
2. That the State Board authorizes the Executive Director to sign the Grant Application.
3. That the Executive Director of the State Board and the Chief of the Division of Clean Water Grants are directed to administer and manage the Construction Grants Program funded by the Fiscal Year 1986 CMAG Grant.
