STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 85-70

AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF A \$190,000 WATER LABORATORY SERVICES CONTRACT TO SUPPORT WATER QUALITY MONITORING IN THE LOWER RUSSIAN RIVER AND LAGUNA DE SANTA ROSA BY THE CALIFORNIA REGIONAL WATER QUALITY CONTROL BOARD NORTH COAST REGION

WHEREAS:

- 1. In response to the concerns of various constituencies, Assemblyman Dan Hauser (2nd Assembly District) requested the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, North Coast Region, (North Coast Regional Board) to propose a water quality monitoring program for the lower Russian River and its tributary, Laguna de Santa Rosa.
- 2. The North Coast Regional Board prepared the subject proposal, and Assemblyman Hauser introduced it to the Legislature for consideration as a special budget item for the Fiscal Year 1985-86.
- 3. Subsequently, both the Legislature and Governor Deukmejian approved the proposed monitoring program, including \$190,000 for contract water laboratory services.
- 4. The North Coast Regional Board needs to solicit bids for water laboratory services in support of the new monitoring program.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board authorizes the Executive Director to execute a water laboratory services contract to support the subject water quality monitoring program for an amount not to exceed \$190,000 for Fiscal Year 1985-86.
