APPROVAL OF THE SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA ASSOCIATION OF GOVERNMENTS' "HAZARDOUS WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN FOR SMALL-QUANTITY GENERATORS: NORTH HOLLYWOOD PILOT STUDY" FINAL REPORT

WHEREAS:

- 1. Pursuant to the terms of a first-cycle 205(j) grant from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), the State Water Resources Control Board (State Board) provided funds to the Southern California Association of Governments (SCAG) to develop a management plan for small-quantity hazardous waste generators.
- 2. SCAG has completed and submitted to the State Board the final report and management plan entitled "Hazardous Waste Management Plan for Small Quantity Generators: North Hollywood Pilot Study".
- 3. The State Board has found that the aforementioned final report conforms to the requirements of the EPA 205(j) grant and to Contract No. 3-105-225-0 under which SCAG received funding.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board approves the aforementioned final report as completion of the contract under which the work was funded, authorizes final payment to SCAG, and directs staff to transmit the final report to EPA as completion of the 205(j) Hazardous Waste Management for Small-Quantity Generators Study.
