STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 85-78

APPROVAL OF THE UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANK (UST) GRANT FOR FEDERAL FISCAL YEAR (FFY) 1985/86

WHEREAS:

- 1. The State Water Resources Control Board (State Board) has been designated by the Governor as the State agency responsible for implementing the UST program established by the Solid Waste Disposal Act, amended by the Hazardous and Solid Waste amendments of 1984.
- 2. The U. S. Environmental Protection Agency, Region 9 (EPA), has indicated that Federal funds in the amount of \$225,000 are available to the State of California to complete the inventory of underground storage tanks as required by Federal law and to complete other activities in the UST program.
- 3. The State Board is applying to the EPA for an UST Grant in the amount of \$225,000 for FFY 1985/86.
- 4. The UST Grant will augment the State Board's Underground Storage Tank Regulatory Program.
- 5. In order to receive Federal funds, the State Board will enter into an agreement with EPA on the UST program for FFY 1985/86.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- 1. The UST grant application is approved.
- The Executive Director is authorized to apply for and accept the UST grant in the amount of \$225,000 and to seek any necessary administrative approvals.
