# ADOPTION OF PRIORITY LIST OF PROJECTS ELIGIBLE FOR POLLUTION STUDY GRANTS

#### WHEREAS:

- 1. The Clean Water Bond Law of 1984 established the Supplemental State Grant Assistance Program to help small communities with funding for treatment works.
- 2. The Supplemental State Grant Assistance Program provides for state grant assistance in an amount up to 97 1/2 percent of pollution studies.
- 3. The State Board's Implementation Plan and Policy for the 1984 Bond Law provides for a task force made up of State Board, Regional Board and small community representatives, to evaluate Regional Board requests and recommend pollution studies to the State Board.
- 4. The task force proposes a Priority List of 78 projects eligible for pollution study grants.
- 5. The Division of Clean Water Grants recommends that 51 pollution studies be funded in FFY 1986.

### THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

- 1. That the attached Priority List of projects eligible for pollution study grants is adopted; and
- 2. That the first 51 pollution studies on the priority list be grant funded.
