STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 85-81

ADOPTION OF AN ADDITION TO THE FY 1985 AND FY 1986 PRIORITY LISTS FOR THE VALLEJO SANITATION AND FLOOD CONTROL DISTRICT

WHEREAS:

- The Vallejo Sanitation and Flood Control District is under an enforcement time schedule to comply with effluent limitations.
- 2. Addition of a biological secondary treatment process to the existing facilities is necessary to meet discharge requirements.
- 3. The State Board previously supported grant funding for the proposed project and in February 1984, the Division of Clean Water Grants processed a grant application for \$12,853,350 (\$9,640,013 federal share).
- 4. The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) subsequently denied grant award.
- 5. The EPA rendered a final decision in April 1984, stating that the proposed project was an ineligible replacement.
- 6. The EPA has now reversed their prior decision and decided in favor of Vallejo on their request for appeal of the final decision.
- 7. Addition of the proposed project to both the FY 1985 and FY 1986 Priority Lists is necessary to reinstate the project to its previous fundable status.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Board, consistent with Section 3623, places the proposed Vallejo Sanitation and Flood Control District biological secondary treatment project in priority Class B on both the FY 1985 and 1986 Priority Lists for immediate funding from FY 1985 carry-over funds.
