STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 85-82

APPROVAL OF THE "MAMMOTH MINE WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT STUDY" FINAL REPORT

WHEREAS:

- 1. Pursuant to the terms of a Phase I 205(j) grant from the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), the State Water Resources Control Board (State Board) provided funds to the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Valley Region (Central Valley Regional Board) to develop a management plan for acid mine drainage from the Mammoth Mine vicinity.
- 2. The State Board and the Central Valley Regional Board developed a contract with the firm of CH2M Hill to study the acid mine drainage problem and prepare a management plan.
- 3. CH2M Hill has completed and submitted to the Central Valley Regional Board a final report, entitled "Mammoth Mine Water Quality Management Planning Study" (Mammoth Mine Study).
- 4. The Central Valley Regional Board approved the Mammoth Mine Study on September 27, 1985 by adopting Resolution No. 85-273.
- 5. The State Board has found that the Mammoth Mine Study conforms to the requirements of the EPA 205(j) grant and to Contract No. 3-128-150-0 under which CH2M Hill performed the work.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board approves the "Mammoth Mine Water Quality Management Planning Study" final report as completion of the contract under which the work was funded, authorizes final payment to CH2M Hill, and directs staff to transmit the final report to EPA as completion of the 205(j) Mammoth Mine Water Quality Management Planning Study.
