STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 85 - 83

APPROVAL OF THE 205(j) FINAL REPORT ENTITLED "ASSESSMENT OF CONTAMINATION FROM LEAKS OF HAZARDOUS MATERIALS IN THE SANTA CLARA VALLEY GROUNDWATER BASIN"

WHEREAS:

- 1. Pursuant to the terms of a Phase I 205(j) grant from the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), the State Water Resources Control Board (State Board) provided funds to the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Francisco Bay Region (San Francisco Bay Regional Board) to conduct an assessment of contamination from leaks of hazardous materials in the Santa Clara Valley ground water basin.
- 2. The San Francisco Bay Regional Board has completed, approved (via Resolution No. 85-015), and submitted to the State Board the 205(j) final report entitled "Assessment of Contamination from Leaks of Hazardous Materials in the Santa Clara Valley Groundwater Basin".
- 3. The State Board has found that the aforementioned final report conforms to the requirements of the EPA 205(j) grant and fulfills the San Francisco Bay Regional Board's project workplan entitled "Assessment of Contamination from Leaks of Hazardous Materials in the Santa Clara Valley Groundwater Basin".
- 4. The State Board has found that the aforementioned final report fulfills the requirements of the contracts with the Santa Clara Valley Water District (No. 3-075-120-0) and the University of California, Berkeley (No. 3-142-120-0).

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

- That the State Board approves the aforementioned final report as fulfillment of the San Francisco Bay Regional Board's 205(j) project workplan.
- 2. That the State Board approves the aforementioned final report as completion of the contracts with the Santa Clara Valley Water District (No. 3-075-120-0) and the University of California, Berkeley (No. 3-142-120-0) and authorizes final payment on those contracts.

3. That the State Board directs staff to transmit the final report to EPA as completion of the 205(j) project entitled Assessment of Contamination from Leaks of Hazardous Materials in the Santa Clara Valley Ground Water Basin.
