STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 85-90

ACCEPTANCE OF THE FINAL REPORTS FOR THE ASSOCIATION
OF BAY AREA GOVERNMENTS' PHASE I 205(j) PROJECT, "THE DISPOSAL
OF HAZARDOUS WASTE BY SMALL QUANTITY GENERATORS"

WHEREAS:

- 1. Pursuant to the terms of a Phase I 205(j) grant from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), the State Water Resources Control Board (State Board) provided funds to the Association of Bay Area Governments (ABAG) to conduct a study regarding the disposal of hazardous waste by small quantity generators.
- 2. ABAG has completed and submitted to the State Board three final reports for this project, entitled:
 - Element A: The <u>Disposal of Hazardous</u> Waste by <u>Small Quantity</u> Generators <u>Magnitude of the Problem</u>
 - Element B: <u>Alternative Disposal Programs for Small Quantity Generators of Hazardous Waste</u>
 - Element C: The <u>Disposal</u> of <u>Hazardous</u> <u>Waste</u> by <u>Small</u> <u>Quantity</u> <u>Generators</u> <u>Recommendations</u> and <u>Guidelines</u>
- 3. The ABAG Executive Board adopted under Resolution No. 11-85 the Element C final report as Appendix P of the San Francisco Bay Area Environmental Management Plan.
- 4. The State Board has found that the aforementioned final reports conform to the requirements of the EPA 205(j) Phase I grant workplan and to Contract No. 3-086-225-0, under which ABAG received funding.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board:

- Accepts the aforementioned final reports as completion of Contract No. 3-086-225-0 under which the work was funded.
- 2. Approves final payment to ABAG for work performed under Contract No. 3-086-225-0.

3. Directs staff to transmit the final reports to EPA as completion of the ABAG 205(j) project, "The Disposal of Hazardous Waste by Small Quantity Generators".
