## STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 85-95

APPROVAL OF THE STATEWIDE LIST OF SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL SITES TO BE ASSESSED PURSUANT TO SECTION 13273 OF THE WATER CODE (ASSEMBLY BILL 3525; CALDERON, 1984)

## WHEREAS:

- 1. Section 13273 of the Water Code requires the State Water Resources Control Board (State Board) to rank all solid waste disposal sites in the State on or before January 1, 1986.
- 2. Operators of the first 150 solid waste disposal sites on the list must prepare solid waste water quality assessment test reports and submit them to the appropriate California Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Board) on or before January 1, 1987.
- 3. The operators of sites in subsequent ranks of 150 on the list must submit an assessment report on or before January 1 of each succeeding year until all sites have been assessed.
- 4. The Regional Boards are required to examine these assessment reports and determine whether any hazardous waste has migrated into ground and surface water adjacent to the solid waste disposal site.
- 5. If a Regional Board determines that hazardous waste has migrated into the waters of the state, it shall notify the State Department of Health Services and the California Waste Management Board and shall take the appropriate remedial action pursuant to Chapter 5 of Division 7 of the Water Code.
- 6. The Regional Boards are required to consider the information provided in the solid waste water quality assessment test report when issuing or revising waste discharge requirements for that site.

## THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

1. The State Board approves the ranked list of solid waste disposal sites attached to this resolution.

- 2. The State Board requests all Regional Boards to notify the operators of solid waste disposal sites in their regions of the need to prepare solid waste water quality assessment test reports and of the appropriate January 1 deadline for submitting these reports to the Regional Board based on the site's ranking. The Regional Boards are also requested to provide an explanation to the site operators of the requirements of Section 13273 of the Water Code.
- 3. The State Board directs staff to report back on the progress of implementing Section 13273 of the Water Code at the March Board Workshop.
