STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 86-19

AUTHORIZING FUNDING FOR DESIGN OF THE MANILA COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT LEACHFIELD DISPOSAL

WHEREAS:

- 1. The State Board adopted Resolution No. 77-90 on October 20, 1977, authorizing the use of the State Bond monies to fund 100% of the eligible design costs of Manila's Innovative/Alternative demonstration project with temporary leachfield disposal.
- State and Federal Clean Water Grant funds, including supplemental innovative/alternative funding, were used to construct Manila's facilities.
- 3. Manila's constructed leachfield disposal was intended to be temporary until the District could connect to the Humboldt Bay Wastewater Authority Regional Sewerage System.
- 4. The Humboldt Bay regional system was not built, and Manila continued to use the temporary leachfield which is now failing.
- 5. Manila has completed planning for permanent leachfield disposal and has requested state funding assistance to complete design.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board approves funding in the amount of \$80,000 from 1978 Bond Funds for design of the Manila Community Services District permanent leachfield disposal facilities.
