STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 86-21

ADOPTION OF REVISED INCOMPATIBLE ACTIVITIES STATEMENT

WHEREAS:

- 1. California Government Code Section 19990 requires each appointing power to adopt an incompatible activities statement governing its employees.
- 2. The State Board adopted an incompatible activities statement in August 1972 and the statement is now out of date.
- A revised incompatible activities statement was prepared and circulated for comment in April 1984 and November 1985.
- 4. The revised incompatible activities statement has been amended in response to the comments which were received.
- 5. Each Regional Board, as an appointing power, is required to adopt an incompatible activities statement for its employees.
- 6. In the interests of consistency and uniformity statewide, the State Board strongly encourages the Regional Boards to take formal action approving this statement.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The revised incompatible activities statement is adopted, and the Executive Director is authorized to transmit the statement, comments, and responses to comments to the Department of Personnel Administration for approval.
