RESOLUTION NO. 86-25

ACCEPTANCE OF A 205(j) PHASE I FINAL REPORT
AS COMPLETION OF THE "GREENHORN AND AFTERTHOUGHT MINES
ACID DRAINAGE CONTROL STUDY"

WHEREAS:

1. Pursuant to the terms of a Phase I 205(j) grant from the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), the State Water Resources Control Board (State Board) provided funds to the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Valley Region (Central Valley Regional Board) to develop a management plan for acid mine drainage from the Greenhorn and Afterthought Mines.
2. The State Board and the Central Valley Regional Board developed a contract with the California Department of Water Resources (DWR) to study the acid mine drainage problems and prepare a management plan.
3. DWR has completed and submitted to the Central Valley Regional Board a final report, entitled The Greenhorn and Afterthought Mines--A Plan for the Control and Abatement of Acid and Heavy Metal Pollution (Greenhorn/Afterthought Mines Report).
4. The Central Valley Regional Board approved the Greenhorn/Afterthought Mines Report on January 24, 1986 by adopting Resolution No. 86-039.
5. The State Board has found that the Greenhorn/Afterthought Mines Report conforms to the requirements of the EPA 205(j) grant and to Contract No. 3-127-150-0 under which DWR performed the work.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board accepts the final report entitled The Greenhorn and Afterthought Mines--A Plan for the Control and Abatement of Acid and Heavy Metal Pollution as completion of Contract No. 3-127-150-0 under which the work was funded and directs staff to transmit the final report to EPA as completion of the 205(j) "Greenhorn and Afterthought Mines Acid Drainage Control Study".
