ADOPTION OF PRIORITY LIST OF PROJECTS ELIGIBLE FOR WATER RECLAMATION LOANS

WHEREAS:

- 1. The Clean Water Bond Law of 1984 established the Water Reclamation Loan Program to provide financial assistance for the design and construction of cost-effective water reclamation projects.
- 2. A Water Reclamation Account was established with \$25 million for loans to municipalities for design and construction of water reclamation projects.
- Applications were submitted for water reclamation loans and were evaluated by staff.
- 4. The Division of Clean Water Grants proposed a priority list of projects eligible to receive water reclamation loans, and evaluated various funding options.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Board hereby 1) adopts the attached priority list of projects eligible to receive water reclamation loans, 2) adopts funding Option 4, Table 2 (attached) for Category A projects and 3) directs staff to work with the applicants of the eligible projects to develop the documentation necessary for Board approval of loans.
