ACCEPTANCE OF THE DIVISION OF WATER QUALITY, POLLUTANT INVESTIGATIONS BRANCH'S PHASE I 205(j) FINAL REPORT AS COMPLETION OF THE "GROUND WATER 'HOT SPOTS': TOXIC POLLUTANT PROBLEM IDENTIFICATION, CORRECTION, AND PREVENTION" PROJECT

WHEREAS:

- 1. Pursuant to the terms of a Phase I 205(j) grant from the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), the State Water Resources Control Board (State Board) provided funds to the Division of Water Quality's Pollutant Investigation Branch to conduct a study entitled "Ground Water 'Hot Spots': Toxic Pollutant Problem Identification, Correction, and Prevention".
- 2. The Pollutant Investigations Branch has completed and submitted to the State Board a final report for this project, entitled <u>Ground Water "Hot Spots": Toxic Pollutant Problem Identification, Correction, and Prevention.</u>
- 3. The State Board has found that the aforementioned final report conforms to the requirements of the EPA Phase I 205(j) grant workplan and to Contract No. 4-058-400-0, under which Luhdorff & Scalmanini, Consulting Engineers, provided hydrogeological expertise and other assistance to the project.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board:

- 1. Accepts the aforementioned final report as completion of the "Ground Water 'Hot Spots': Toxic Pollutant Problem Identification, Correction, and Prevention" Phase I 205(j) Project.
- Authorizes final payment to Luhdorff & Scalmanini, Consulting Engineers, for work performed under Contract No. 4-058-400-0.

3. Directs staff to transmit the final report to EPA as completion of the Pollutant Investigations Branch's Phase I 205(j) project entitled "Ground Water 'Hot Spots': Toxic Pollutant Problem Identification, Correction, and Prevention".
