STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 86-38

ACCEPTANCE OF THE FINAL REPORT FOR THE STATE COASTAL CONSERVANCY'S PHASE I 205(j) "BUENA VISTA LAGOON SEDIMENT CONTROL STUDY"

WHEREAS:

- 1. Pursuant to the terms of a Phase I 205(j) grant from the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), the State Water Resources Control Board (State Board) contracted with the State Coastal Conservancy (Conservancy) to develop a management plan to protect Buena Vista Lagoon in San Diego County from sedimentation.
- 2. The Conservancy has completed and submitted to the State Board a final report, entitled <u>Buena Vista Lagoon Watershed Sediment Control Plan</u> (Buena Vista Plan), including an attached Implementation Plan.
- 3. The State Board has found that the Buena Vista Plan meets the requirements of the EPA 205(j) grant and of Interagency Agreement No. 3-088-225-0 under which the Conservancy performed the work.
- 4. The Conservancy is commended for actively pursuing implementation of the Buena Vista Plan with the cities of Carlsbad, Oceanside, and Vista and may commit State funds under its control to implementation of the Buena Vista Plan.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board:

- Accepts the Buena Vista Plan as completion of Interagency Agreement No. 3-088-225-0 under which the work was funded.
- Directs staff to transmit the Buena Vista Plan to EPA as completion of the 205(j) "Buena Vista Lagoon Sediment Control Study".

3. Strongly urges the Conservancy and the cities of Carlsbad, Oceanside, and Vista to fully implement the recommendations of the Buena Vista Plan.
