RESOLUTION NO. 86- 43

CLEAN WATER LOANS FOR SMALL COMMUNITIES RECEIVING  
SUPPLEMENTAL STATE GRANT ASSISTANCE

WHEREAS:


1. The question has been raised whether small communities qualifying for supplemental state grant assistance are also eligible to receive a loan from the Clean Water Construction Grant Account.
2. The Clean Water Bond Law of 1984, under Section 13999.8(f), states that communities receiving less than a 75 percent federal grant are entitled to a loan for up to 12-1/2 percent of the federally eligible project costs.
3. Staff has reviewed comments received at the March 6, 1986 Workshop and investigated four alternatives for providing assistance to small, needy communities in a Staff Report mailed to interested parties on April 4, 1986.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Board approves the issuance of loans from the Clean Water Construction Grant Account to small communities also receiving supplemental grants. In no event shall the combined state and federal grant and loan assistance exceed 97-1/2 percent of the total state eligible project cost determined in accordance with the State Board's Implementation Plan on small communities supplemental assistance. In no case shall the loan from the Clean Water Construction Grant Account exceed 12-1/2 percent of the federally eligible cost.
