# STATE WATER RESOURCE CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 86-62

## ADOPTION OF THE CALIFORNIA NPDES COMPLIANCE POLICY

### WHEREAS:

- 1. The Clean Water Act, Section 301 (CWA) requires all Publicly Owned Treatment Works (POTWs) to achieve compliance with water-quality-based and technology-based requirements contained in National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permits.
- 2. On January 30, 1984, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) published the National Municipal Policy (NMP) which outlines EPA's approach to assuring POTW compliance by July 1, 1988.
- 3. Pursuant to the NMP, on March 15, 1984, the State Board adopted Resolution No. 84-20, the California NPDES Compliance Policy (State Policy).
- 4. The State Policy laid the groundwork for identifying POTWs in noncompliance and the methods for bringing them into compliance.
- 5. The NMP recognizes that extraordinary circumstances may preclude compliance by some POTWs on or before July 1, 1988.
- 6. The State Policy has been updated to include a description of how California will address POTWs that will not achieve compliance by July 1, 1988.
- 7. The State Policy has also been updated to include a description of how California will address POTWs that must achieve compliance with NPDES permit requirements not covered by the NMP.

### THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

- 1. That the State Board adopts the updated California NPDES Compliance Policy and authorizes the Executive Director to transmit the policy to EPA. Region 9.
- 2. That the State Board rescinds the California NPDES Compliance Policy adopted on March 15, 1984 (Resolution No. 84-20).
