RESOLUTION NO. 86-64

APPROVING THE ISSUANCE OF TWO INNOVATIVE/ALTERNATIVE (I/A) GRANTS BEFORE APPROVAL-TO-AWARD (ATA)

WHEREAS:

- The I/A Program now has \$3,492,308 in its federal fiscal year (FFY) 1985 accounts which must be allocated to qualified I/A projects before September 30, 1985, or EPA will reallot these funds to other states.
- 2. Present Board procedures specify that bonus I/A funds will be awarded only after the grantee receives ATA.
- 3. The Board's present I/A Program policy and procedures state that bonus I/A grants will be awarded to qualified I/A projects which have already received basic federal construction grants but did not receive I/A bonus grants if the mandatory I/A set aside for any given fiscal year has not already been allocated to higher priority I/A projects.
- 4. Los Angeles County Sanitation Districts' (LACSD) "Carver-Greenfield" sludge dehydration-energy recovery project qualifies for the highest I/A bonus grant priority.
- 5. LACSD's sludge dehydration-energy recovery project contracts are entitled to I/A bonus grants of about \$6.7 million but would not receive ATA until November 1986.

THEREFORE IT BE RESOLVED:

That the Board approves an exception to its I/A program procedures and directs the Division of Clean Water Grants to issue LACSD bonus I/A grants concurrently with basic federal grant assistance.
