STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 86-75A

AUTHORIZING RENEWAL OF A LABORATORY SERVICES CONTRACT WITH ANATEC LABORATORIES, INCORPORATED, TO SUPPORT WATER QUALITY MONITORING IN THE RUSSIAN RIVER AND THE LAGUNA DE SANTA ROSA BY THE CALIFORNIA REGIONAL WATER QUALITY CONTROL BOARD, NORTH COAST REGION

WHEREAS:

- 1. The Budget Act of 1985, Item 3940-001-001, Provision (J), authorized funding of a major water quality monitoring program for the Russian River and the Laguna de Santa Rosa.
- This legislative augmentation was continued as part of the State Board's baseline budget for FY 1986-87, again including \$100,000 for contract laboratory services.
- 3. The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, North Coast Region, (North Coast Regional Board) intends to continue its special Russian River/Laguna de Santa Rosa water quality monitoring program in FY 1986-87.
- 4. Anatec Laboratories, Incorporated, has provided satisfactory laboratory analytical services to the North Coast Regional Board in support of its monitoring program, and has indicated its desire and capability to continue to do so in FY 1986-87.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Executive Director is hereby authorized to renew a laboratory services contract with Anatec Laboratories, Incorporated, to support the North Coast Regional Board's special Russian River water quality monitoring program in an amount not to exceed \$100,000 in FY 1986-87 General Fund monies through June 30, 1987.
