STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 86 - 78

ADOPTION OF PRIORITY LIST OF PROJECTS ELIGIBLE FOR AGRICULTURAL DRAINAGE WATER MANAGEMENT LOANS

WHEREAS:

- 1. The Water Conservation and Water Quality Bond Law of 1986 established the Agricultural Drainage Water Management Loan Program to provide financial assistance for the design and construction of agricultural drainage water management facilities; and
- 2. The Agricultural Drainage Water Account was established with \$75 million for loans to local agencies for a) design and construction of agricultural drainage water management facilities, and b) feasibility studies of projects potentially eligible for funding; and
- The applications were submitted for agricultural drainage water management loans and were evaluated by staff; and
- 4. The Division of Clean Water Grants proposed a priority list of projects eligible to receive agricultural drainage water management loans.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Board hereby 1) adopts the attached priority list of projects eligible to receive agricultural drainage water management loans, and 2) directs staff to work with the applicants of the eligible projects to develop the documentation necessary for Board approval of loans.
