STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 86-80

AN INCREASE TO THE APPROVED STATE SUPPLEMENTAL ASSISTANCE GRANT FOR THE LOS ALAMOS COMMUNITY SERVICE DISTRICT PROJECT NO. C-06-1664

WHEREAS:

- The State Board, by Resolution No. 86-47 dated June 19, 1986, approved the award of a state supplemental assistance grant for \$833,000 to the Los Alamos Community Service District.
- 2. Due to a substantial increase in project construction costs and engineering and administrative costs, the total project cost has now increased to \$3.6 million. This compares to the previous cost estimate of \$2.8 million (the engineer's estimate at the time the existing state supplemental grant was awarded). This amounts to about 28 percent above the engineer's original estimate.
- 3. In accordance with the Board's Implementation Plan and Policy, a high cost project in excess of \$2.5 million and over 15 percent above the engineer's estimate, must demonstrate to the Board that it is the most cost-effective project.
- 4. The requested increase to the approved state supplemental grant amount will not result in a combined federal and state assistance of more than 97.5 percent of the project eligible costs.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

- 1. That the State Board has determined that the proposed project, at a total estimated project cost of \$3.6 million, remains the most cost-effective solution to the water quality problem.
- 2. The State Board approves a grant increase of \$214,000 to the approved state supplemental grant.
- 3. The state supplemental grant for the Los Alamos Community Services District is hereby increased to \$1,047,000.
