APPROVING NEGATIVE DECLARATION FOR THE MAZ PROPERTIES, INC.
DBA EL RANCHO TAJIGUAS, TIJIGUAS CREEK PROJECT,
WATER RIGHT APPLICATION 27290

WHEREAS:


1. Applicant has filed Application 27290 to appropriate 106 acre-feet per annum (afa) from Tajiguas Creek by diversion to storage. The water is to be diverted from November 1 of each year through April 15 of the succeeding year and is to be stored in one onstream reservoir and four offstream reservoirs. The purposes of use are irrigation, stockwatering, fire protection and wildlife enhancement.
2. The Board as Lead Agency has prepared an Initial Study and Negative Declaration for the applicant's project.
3. The Initial Study and Negative Declaration were circulated for public review in accordance with Title 14 of the California Administrative Code, Sections 15072 and 15073. Five letters of comment were received.
4. Having considered the proposed Negative Declaration and the comments received, the Board finds that there is no substantial evidence that the project, as conditioned by the terms of the water right permit, will have a significant effect on the environment.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The State Water Resources Control Board approves the Negative Declaration.
