STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 86-92

CHANGES IN THE RANKINGS OF THE LIST OF SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL SITES FOR SECTION 13273 OF THE WATER CODE

WHEREAS:

- 1. Section 13273 of the Water Code requires the State Water Resources Control Board (State Board) to rank all solid waste disposal sites in the State with 150 disposal sites per rank.
- The State Board has approved a list of solid waste disposal sites containing 2087 entires and 14 ranks.
- 3. The Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Coast Region, and the Regional Water Quality Control Board, Santa Ana Region have requested substantiated changes to the list of solid waste disposal sites to result in the following:

Bauman's Auto Wrecking Site	Deleted
Riverside County - Double Butte Landfill	Rank 1
Fort Hunter Liggett Landfill	Rank 2
Redlands City - Church Street Fill	Rank 2

2. The State Board directs staff to notify the Department of the Army, Riverside County, the City of Redlands, Bauman's Auto Wrecking, and the Regional Water Quality Control Boards.
