- 1. Pursuant to the terms of a Phase II 205(j) grant from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), the State Water Resources Control Board (State Board) provided funds to the Association of Monterey Bay Area Governments (AMBAG) to conduct a Timber Harvest Erosion Control Workshop (Workshop).
- 2. AMBAG conducted the Workshop on April 23-25, 1986 and submitted to the State Board the documents entitled <u>Timber Harvest Erosion Control Workshop</u> and <u>Summary of Proceedings</u>.
- 3. The State Board has found that the Workshop and the documents conform to the requirements of the EPA 205(j) Phase II grant workplan and to Contract No. 5-142-250-0 under which AMBAG received funding.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board:

- Accepts the aforementioned documents as completion of Contract No. 5-142-250-0 under which the work was funded.
- 2. Approves final payment to AMBAG for work performed under Contract No. 5-142-250-0.
- 3. Directs staff to transmit copies of the documents to EPA as completion of the AMBAG Phase II 205(j) "Timber Harvest Erosion Control Workshop Project".
