ACCEPTANCE OF SANTA CRUZ COUNTY'S PHASE II 205(j) FINAL REPORT AS COMPLETION OF THE "SOQUEL CREEK CHRONIC SEDIMENT SOURCE INVENTORY" PROJECT

WHEREAS:

- 1. Pursuant to the terms of a Phase II 205(j) grant from the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), the State Water Resources Control Board (State Board) contracted with Santa Cruz County to develop a plan to improve water quality and anadromous fish habitat in Soquel Creek by identifying and proposing treatment of chronic sediment sources.
- 2. Santa Cruz County has completed and submitted to the State Board a final report entitled, <u>Soquel Creek Chronic Sediment Source Inventory</u>, <u>Final Report</u>, including an Implementation Plan.
- 3. The State Board has found that the <u>Soquel Creek Chronic Sediment Source Inventory</u>, <u>Final Report meets the requirements of the EPA 205(j) grant and of Standard Agreement No. 5-134-250-0 under which Santa Cruz County performed the work.</u>

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board:

1. Accepts the <u>Soquel Creek Chronic Sediment Source Inventory</u>, Final Report as completion of Standard Agreement No. 5-134-250-0 under which the work was funded.

- 2. Directs staff to transmit the <u>Soquel Creek Chronic Sediment Source Inventory</u>, <u>Final Report to EPA as completion of the 205(j)</u> "Soquel Creek Chronic Sediment Source Inventory" Project.
- 3. Authorizes final payment to Santa Cruz County for work performed under Standard Agreement No. 5-134-250-0.
