STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 87-29

ESTABLISHMENT OF THE FY 1987-88 ANNUAL FEES FOR FACILITIES SUBJECT TO THE TOXIC PITS CLEANUP ACT

WHE REAS:

- 1. The State Water Resources Control Board (State Board) is required, pursuant to Section 2201(c)(2) of Title 23 of the California Administrative Code, to set fees payable by any person discharging any liquid hazardous waste or hazardous waste containing free liquids into a surface impoundment.
- 2. The State Board has considered budgetary requirements of the Toxic Pits Cleanup Act program for FY 1987-88 and anticipated revenues from the 1987 fees.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the annual fees payable on July 1, 1987 by persons discharging liquid hazardous waste or hazardous waste containing free liquids to surface impoundments be set in the amount of \$3,000 for each facility, plus \$300 for each additional surface impoundment at the facility, pursuant to Section 2201(c)(2) of Title 23 of the California Administrative Code.
