

STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD
RESOLUTION NO. 87-31

AUTHORIZING NEGOTIATION AND EXECUTION OF AN INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT OR CONTRACT WITH THE UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA (UC), THE CALIFORNIA STATE UNIVERSITY (CSU), OR A PRIVATE PARTY, TO CONDUCT A STUDY OF MATTERS RELATED TO MINING WASTE AND WATER QUALITY DEGRADATION IN CALIFORNIA IN FY 1986-87 AND FY 1987-88

WHEREAS:

1. The State Water Control Resources Board (State Board) has been designated as the lead agency for an investigation of mining waste and associated water quality degradation; and
2. There is insufficient State Board staff available to perform the necessary work within the estimated time frame; and
3. The State Board is permitted to contract for the performance of the study.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board authorizes the Executive Director or his designee to negotiate and execute an interagency agreement or contract with the UC, CSU, or private party, to conduct a study of matters related to mining waste and water quality degradation in California for an amount not to exceed \$100,000.
