STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 87-45

AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF AN INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT WITH THE PUBLIC EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM FOR PAYMENT OF COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH STATE AND REGIONAL BOARD PARTICIPATION IN THE EARLY RETIREMENT PROGRAM

WHEREAS:

- 1. The State Water Resources Control Board (State Board) and the Regional Water Quality Control Boards (Regional Boards) have been authorized and directed by Executive Order D-60-86 to participate in the Early Retirement Program which provides a two (2) year service credit to eligible employees who retire between January 30, 1987 and May 29, 1987.
- 2. The estimated cost of twenty (20) State and Regional Board employees participating in the Early Retirement Program is approximately \$267,000 which will be offset by savings in FY 1986-87.
- 3. The Public Employees' Retirement System (PERS) will pay the full cost of State and Regional Board participation in the Early Retirement Program in FY 1986-87 contingent upon an executed Interagency Agreement providing for repayment of these costs by June 30, 1987.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board authorizes the Executive Director or his designee to execute an Interagency Agreement in the amount of approximately \$267,000 with PERS for payment of costs associated with State and Regional Board participation in the Early Retirement Program.
