STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 87-48

AUTHORIZING NEGOTIATION AND EXECUTION OF A CONTRACT WITH THE CALIFORNIA ASSOCIATION OF ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH ADMINISTRATORS FOR OPERATION OF THE UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANK PERMIT INFORMATION SYSTEM IN FY 1987-88

WHEREAS:

- The State Water Resources Control Board (State Board) is required by law to store permit application information for the purposes of managing and appropriately cross-referencing and indexing such information concerning underground storage tanks.
- The State Board has selected the California Association of Environmental Health Administrators (CAEHA) to operate the Underground Storage Tank Permit Information System in accordance with Section 25286(b)(1) of the Health and Safety Code.
- Contracting with CAEHA is consistent with the Governor's policy of delegating much of the responsibility for the Underground Storage Tank Program to local government.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board authorizes the Executive Director or his designee to negotiate and execute a contract with the California Association of Environmental Health Administrators for an amount not to exceed \$250,000 in FY 1987-88 monies for operation of the Underground Storage Tank Permit Information System through June 30,1988, subject to availability of funds.
