STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 87-51

CLEAN WATER GRANT FUNDING PRIORITIES FOR SOLIDS HANDLING/DISPOSAL PROJECTS

WHEREAS:

- There are inadequate grant monies available to fund project needs for public health, water quality, and the July 1988 compliance deadline for secondary treatment.
- There are ten solids handling/disposal projects currently on the FY 1987 five-year Clean Water Grant Priority List that have been identified as providing facilities in excess of those needed to achieve a sludge cake of 20 percent solids.
- 3. Grant monies must be directed to solving the more critical water quality and public health problems.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

- That the Policy limiting funding of solids handling facilities for all grants awarded after May 21, 1987, is adopted.
- 2. That the ten projects identified in Exhibit A be reclassified to Priority Class H Other Projects.
