STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 87-59

ACCEPTANCE OF THE FINAL REPORT FOR THE COUNTY OF SAN BERNARDINO'S PHASE I 205(j)
"CHINO AGRICULTURAL PRESERVE DRAINAGE AND LAND USE STUDY"

WHEREAS:

- 1. Uncontrolled urban runoff in western San Bernardino County is a major contributing cause for dairies in the Chino Agricultural Preserve area to violate waste discharge requirements imposed by the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Santa Ana Region (Santa Ana Regional Board).
- 2. Pursuant to the terms of a Phase I 205(j) grant from the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), the State Water Resources Control Board (State Board) contracted with the County of San Bernardino (County) to develop a management plan to protect the Chino Agricultural Preserve from uncontrolled urban runoff.
- 3. The County has completed and submitted to the State Board a final report, entitled <u>Chino Agricultural Preserve 205(j)</u>
 <u>Drainage and Land Use Plan</u> (Chino Plan).
- 4. The State Board has found that the Chino Plan meets the requirements of the EPA Phase I 205(j) grant and of Standard Agreement No. 3-144-225-1 under which the County performed the work.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board:

- Accepts the aforementioned final report as completion of the Phase I 205(j) "Chino Agricultural Preserve Drainage and Land Use Study" (Study).
- 2. Authorizes final payment to the County for work performed under Standard Agreement No. 3-144-225-1.

 Directs staff to transmit the Chino Plan to EPA as completion of the 205(j) Phase I Study.
