## STATE WATER RESOURCE CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 87-68

# APPROVAL TO AWARD SUPPLEMENTAL STATE GRANT ASSISTANCE TO THE REDWOOD PARK COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT - PROJECT NO C-06-2946-110

### WHEREAS:

- 1. The Redwood Park Community Services District project received an EPA grant (Step 4) in September 1985 for a total eligible cost of \$157,315; and
- 2. The Division of Clean Water Grants is reviewing the plans and specifications for the project; and
- 3. The Redwood Park community has a population less than 5,000. Total eligible project costs are estimated to be under \$2.5 million; and
- 4. The State Board's Implementation Plan and Policy for the Clean Water Bond Law of 1984 provides that small, needy communities may receive a supplemental state assistance grant after receiving approval of final plans and specifications; and
- 5. The State Board's Implementation Plan and Policy provides that the amount of the supplemental grant be determined by using the formula contained in that document. The above document limits the combined federal and state grant assistance to a maximum of 97.5% of the total eligible costs; and
- 6. The requested supplemental grant will not result in a combined federal and state assistance of more than 97.5% of the project eligible costs.

### THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

- The State Board has determined that Redwood Park Community Services
  District is eligible to receive a supplemental state grant under the 1984
  Clean Water Bond Law.
- The State Board approves the award of state supplemental grant assistance in the amount of \$78,000 to the Redwood Park Community Services District.
