STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 87-74

APPROVING AN AMENDMENT FOR LOS ANGELES COUNTY SANITATION DISTRICTS (LACSD) GRANT NO. C-06-1833-110-01 - REALLOCATION OF FUNDS

WHEREAS:

- The Los Angeles County Sanitation Districts (LACSD) have received grant funding for a fluidized combustion/air pollution control facility.
- 2. Grant contract C-06-1833-140 originally included the installation of refractory into the fluidized bed boilers.
- Recently it was determined that a welded tube (waterwall) is more cost effective than the refractory.
- Design of the fluidized bed boilers has been changed to accommodate the waterwall design.
- 5. Fabrication of the waterwall and associated equipment will be supplied under the equipment purchase contract (C-06-1833-110-01).
- 6. LACSD has asked the State Board to reallocate \$2,263,310 from contract C-06-1833-140, to the equipment purchase contract, C-06-1833-110-01, to accommodate the waterwall design change.
- 7. Staff have reviewed the LACSD submittal and agree that the waterwall is more cost effective.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board approves the reallocation of \$2,263,310 from contract C-06-1833-140 to contract C-06-1833-110-01 to accommodate the change to waterwall and the purchase of necessary equipment.
