STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 87-91

APPROVING A STATE WATER QUALITY CONTROL FUND LOAN TO SAN LORENZO VALLEY WATER DISTRICT (DISTRICT)

WHEREAS:

- 1. Assembly bill (AB) 1618, Chapter 962, Statutes of 1986, authorizes the Board to make a loan, not to exceed \$1.5 million to the District; and
- 2. As a condition of loan approval, the Board must certify that the District has an enforceable collection system for repayment of the loan including interest; and
- 3. The Central Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board by Resolution No. 87-04 certified the adequacy of a program proposed by the County of Santa Cruz to ensure that the use of on-site wastewater disposal systems will not pollute waters of the state; and
- 4. The District has agreed that it will not undertake certain activities related to disposal of sewage from on-site waste water disposal systems during the actual term of the loan; and
- 5. The District in October 1987 will hold an election as required by Section 13416 of the Porter-Cologne Act at which more than 50 percent of the votes cast must favor the loan; and
- 6. The Board, pursuant to AB 1618, may require that the District immediately repay the outstanding loan balance to the extent of receipt by the District of any state mandated costs; and
- 7. The loan for \$1.5 million will be repaid in 15 years at an interest rate of 3.4 percent, if awarded in 1987.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

- 1. That the Board hereby approves and certifies the District's report as required by AB 1618.
- 2. That the Board hereby authorizes the Executive Director or his designee to execute, for and on behalf of the Board, a contract with the District for a loan pursuant to AB 1618 and the Porter-Cologne Act, subject to items 3 and 4 below.
- 3. The loan contract shall not be executed prior to the time the District has held an election at which more than 50 percent of the votes cast favor the loan.
- 4. The loan contract shall contain a provision requiring immediate repayment of the outstanding loan balance to the extent of receipt by the District of any state mandated costs.
