ACCEPTANCE OF THE SAN DIEGO ASSOCIATION OF GOVERNMENTS'
PHASE II 205(j) FINAL REPORT AS COMPLETION OF THE
"MANAGEMENT OF NUTRIENT INPUTS INTO SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA
COASTAL LAGOONS" STUDY

WHEREAS:

- 1. Pursuant to the terms of a Phase II 205(j) grant from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), the State Water Resources Control Board (State Board) contracted with the San Diego Association of Governments (SANDAG) to develop and perform tests to provide information to the San Diego Regional Water Quality Control Board (San Diego Regional Board) to determine the adequacy of existing water quality standards for coastal lagoons.
- 2. SANDAG has completed and submitted to the State Board a final report entitled <u>Algal Community Response to Nitrogen and Phosphorous Loadings in Experimental Mesocosms: Management Recommendations for Southern California Coastal Lagoons, (Final Report) including an Implementation Plan.</u>
- 3. The State Board has found that the Final Report meets the requirements of the EPA 205(j) grant and Standard Agreement No. 5-135-250-0 under which SANDAG performed the work.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board:

- 1. Accepts the aforementioned Final Report as completion of Standard Agreement No. 5-135-250-0 under which the work was performed.
- 2. Directs staff to transmit the Final Report to EPA as completion of the Phase II 205(j) "Management of Nutrient Inputs into Southern California Coastal Lagoons" Study.

3. Authorizes final payment to SANDAG for work performed under Standard Agreement No. 5-135-250-0.
