STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 87-99

APPROVAL OF AMENDMENTS TO THE WATER QUALITY CONTROL PLAN FOR THE NORTH COASTAL BASIN AMENDING THE INTERIM ACTION PLAN FOR THE CITY OF SANTA ROSA AND THE RUSSIAN RIVER BASIN LONG-RANGE ACTION PLAN

WHEREAS:

- 1. The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, North Coast Region (North Coast Regional Board) adopted the Water Quality Control Plan for the North Coastal Basin (Basin Plan) on March 20, 1975.
- Under the Basin Plan, waste discharges to the Russian River, including those of the City of Santa Rosa, were prohibited during the period from May 15 through September 30 each year.
- 3. The City of Santa Rosa declared its goal to eliminate the discharges of wastewater to the Russian River and is in the process of developing a long-term plan to accomplish this objective.
- 4. The North Coast Regional Board adopted an Interim Action Plan for the City of Santa Rosa in Regional Board Resolution No. 86-121 on June 27, 1986.
- 5. The State Board approved most portions on the Interim Action Plan for the Santa Rosa area, but remanded a specific section of the Action Plan to the North Coast Regional Board for reinstatement of language pertaining to the discharge prohibition and for clarification.
- 6. The North Coast Regional Board adopted a Long-Range Action Plan for the Russian River in Resolution No. 86-148 on August 28, 1986.
- 7. The State Board remanded the proposed Long-Range Action Plan to the North Coast Regional Board for clarification pertaining to the action plan implementation date, definition of waste type, and discharger reporting procedures.
- 8. The proposed amendment as described in the North Coast Regional Board Resolution No. 87-58 pertaining to the Santa Rosa area Interim Action Plan and the Russian River Long-Range Action Plan follow the State Board's recommendation as adopted through State Board Resolution No. 86-76 and No. 87-33.

- 9. The proposed amendments to the Point Source Measures Section of the Plan are appropriate and in accordance with State Board requests as outlined State Board Resolution No. 86-76 and No. 87-33.
- 10. The proposed Basin Plan amendments are consistent with the requirements of Public Resources Code Section 21000 et seq. (California Environmental Quality Act).
- 11. Basin plan amendments do not become effective until approved by the State Board.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the amendments to the Basin Plan pertaining to as adopted in North Coast Regional Board Resolution No. 87-58 on May 28, 1987 be approved.
