STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO.87 - 102

APPROVAL OF THE GROUND WATER QUALITY PROTECTION STRATEGY FOR CALIFORNIA

WHEREAS:

- The State Board was designated as the lead agency to develop a ground water quality protection strategy for California.
- California has recently undergone a series of federal and state statutory revisions that directly or indirectly deals with ground water.
- 3. The legislatively directed programs have developed independently due to time schedules.
- 4. The State Board held two hearings to receive public comments on a draft ground water quality protection strategy.
- 5. The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency developed a national strategy which relies on individual state strategies.

That the State Board adopts the attached Ground Water Quality Protection Strategy for California.
